The European Youth Team Championships, established in 1968, is the flagship competition of the EBL youth programme. Originally, it comprised only the Junior series (players up to 25 years old); the Schools series (players up to 20 years) was added in 1994, while the Girls series (for female Juniors) was inaugurated last year. The Championships are open to all EBL member countries. Each country may be represented by one national team in each series, consisting of 4-6 players.

Riccione

RICCIONE is a picturesque maritime tourist resort town, situated on the outskirts of Rimini, on Italyís Adriatic coast. Riccione attracts thousands of holiday makers every year, thanks to its beaches, bars & clubs, sports possibilities, shopping, restaurants, etc. Riccione is 230 km away from Milan and Florence, 190 km from Venice and 110km from Bologna which provides the closest major international airport. San Marino is just 30 km from Riccione.

Accommodation

Screens

Table screens will be used in all series throughout.

Dress Code

Teams are expected to be dressed appropriately during play, and especially at the ceremonies where uniform outfit is strongly encouraged.

Not allowed

Smoking and alcohol drinking, as well as the use of mobile phones, pagers and any kind of electronic communication devices in the playing area are strictly prohibited.
